## *Jeffersonville Soccer Club Parent/Player Contract 2009 Season*

The role that parents play in the life of a soccer player has a tremendous impact on their experience. With this in mind, we have taken some time to write down some helpful reminders for all of us as we approach the upcoming season. If you should have any questions regarding these points, please feel free to discuss it with us.

1. Let the coaches coach: Leave the coaching to the coaches. This includes motivating, after game critiquing, setting goals, requiring additional training, etc. You have entrusted the care of your player to the coaches and we need to be free to do our job. If a player has too many coaches, it is confusing for him/her and it inhibits performance.
  
2. Support the program: Get involved. Volunteer. Help out with fundraising, car-pooling, anything that will support the team. Without your support, the team and club cannot excel.
  
3. Fundraising: As you know with any organization, there are many hidden fees that registration does not cover. Each year, Jeffersonville Soccer Club conducts a lottery fundraiser in the fall. This one and only fundraiser helps to keep the cost of registration down, help subsidize the referee fees, field maintenance, equipment, and allows us to bring the cost of our banquet down a little at the end of the season. This is so very important to the club. Unlike most organizations, we chose not to make you pay upfront. We trust our parents and players to make their own contributions later on in the season. We also try to give the person with the most sold tickets something back for their efforts. Thank you for all of those who help the organization.
  
4. Encourage trust: If your child is having difficulties in practice/games, or can't make a practice, encourage them to speak directly to their coaches. Allowing them to take responsibility of their own actions will make them better players in the future.
  
5. Understand and display appropriate behavior: Be supportive and positive to each player on the team. Do not judge a player by an individual game. We all have bad days. This is truly a team sport. To perform to the best of their abilities, a player needs to focus on the parts of the game that they can control individually, (i.e. fitness, positioning, decision-making, skills, and aggressiveness). Do not focus on what you cannot control, (i.e. field conditions, referees, weather, opponents, and unruly spectators). When these situations are enhanced, the tempers of the players and parents escalate as well. A coach will be the only one allowed to make comments to the referees.

If you are red carded or have been asked to leave the field, you will be fined \$50 for misconduct by ICSL and you will be billed directly. This applies to both players and parents. Jeffersonville Soccer Club will not be held responsible financially for fines. So remember, please control your tempers and comments.

6. Sportsmanship: Please encourage good sportsmanship whether you have won or lost the game. Your integrity is at stake and so is the integrity of Jeffersonville Soccer Club.

You represent our club and we will not tolerate poor sportsmanship from players, siblings, or parents.

7. Commitment: This is very important to both the club and the coaches. Our goal as coaches is to challenge the players to reach past their comfort level. If they don't want to exceed their limits, they should be playing intramural sports. Club soccer is for those who want to excel in the sport. Our coaches take it serious and so should you and your child. But along with the hard work, we want to make the season a fun and safe environment for your child.

We understand that many of the players have several commitments between academics, school sports, and club ball. You are the one choosing to play at this level. Our coaches and board have committed themselves 100% to making this club a success and helping your child become better soccer players. They deserve the same respect. We feel that your number one commitment athletically should be toward JSC. Do not take a roster spot if you do not feel that you can commit to this.

8. Education: Above all, we value your education. We take into consideration that you are young, intelligent, growing individuals that should put education high up on your priority list. Please feel free to discuss conflicts with games and practices with each coach individually. Jeffersonville Soccer Club prides itself on not only our achievements athletically, but also academically.
